

Post-Operative Instructions and Care:

If you had foot or ankle surgery, please follow the instructions below or otherwise instructed by *your* physician.

- 1. It is <u>very</u> important to REST, ICE AND ELEVATE your operative foot/ankle after surgery.
- 2. Ice operative site for 15-20 minutes every 2-3 hours after surgery. Please be sure to keep your post- operative dressing dry.
- 3. You may notice a small amount of blood on your dressing after surgery. This is normal. Please rest, ice and elevate your foot/ankle. If the bloody drainage does not stop, please notify your surgeon and/or go to the closest emergency room.
- 4. Please keep your dressing dry, clean and intact. Do not remove it unless specified by your surgeon.
- 5. Take your pain medication as prescribed.
- 6. You may notice a sore throat and/or upset stomach after surgery. This can be normal. Please notify your surgeon if symptoms persist or at anytime you feel necessary.
- 7. It is *very* important to follow the weight-bearing status your physician discussed with you.
- 8. If you were prescribed a special shoe or boot to use after surgery, please follow your surgeon's instructions.
- 9. If you were prescribed crutches, a walker or a wheelchair, please follow your surgeon's instructions.
